

NOTICE

The Government of India has issued following instructions to ensure proper use of all categories of the Tourist Visa:

1. In respect of foreign national holding Tourist Visas with a multiple entry facility, there should be gap of at least two months between two visits to India on such a Tourist Visa.
2. If any foreign national is required to visit the country again within a period of two months of his last exit, such foreign national should obtain special permission from the Indian Embassy/Consulates concerned. Such re-entry within the stipulated gap of two months may be permitted only in emergency situations. In all cases a confirmed itinerary and documentation in support of emergency will be required.
3. In all cases the foreign passport must have at least 2 blank pages.
4. All such requests will be considered on merits of each case by the Indian Embassies/Consulates abroad.
5. In all such cases, the foreign national should register himself with the FRRO/FRO concerned within 14 days of arrival. An endorsement to this effect will be made on the visa sticker.
6. The foreign nationals who possess business/ employment /Medical/ diplomatic visas or have OCI/PIO cards are not covered under this provision.
7. **Miscellaneous Consular fee of US\$25 + US\$13** (As service charges of the Travisa) will be charged for making the endorsement in the valid foreign passport. . The application has to be submitted at [M/s Travisa](#).
